



Mt Rosa Wines Tasting Notes – Autumn 2014



2010 Mt Rosa Pinot Noir

“Dusty blackberry, plum and spicy brooding aromatics followed by a lush and elegant multi layered texture. This wine shows great density and length.”

Alcohol 13.0% pH 3.70
T/A 6.0 g/l R/S 0-1 g/l



2013 Mt Rosa Rose

“Redcurrant with wild strawberry and spice aromatics. Followed by a soft and silky texturally driven palate. Nice persistence with a dry finish.”

Alcohol 13.5% R/S 2-4 g/l



2009 Mt Rosa Pinot Gris

“Lime, aniseed and river rock aromatics with a warm peach and bready palate, great coverage and a long lasting finish. “

Alcohol 13.5% pH 3.61
TA 7.0 g/l R/S 0-1 g/l



2011 Late Harvest Riesling 375 ml

“Honeydew, lime and loquat aromatics, followed by a lush enveloping palate. This wine shows obvious opulence and sweetness, but is elegant, persistent, vibrant and dense.”

Alcohol 11% R/S 125 g/l



2010 Mt Rosa Riesling

“Loquat, lime, marzipan and spicy floral aromatics. The mouthfeel is lithe and sensuous with spicy citrus flavours, good persistence and depth.”

Alcohol 11.5% pH 3.18
TA 9 g/l R/S 6-9 g/l
